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## **DECLARATION INFORMATION**

### **Cattle Identification**

- Cattle must be double tagged with clearly readable and complete tags as required by the Cattle Identification Regulations.
- Each consignment of cattle must be accompanied by a Movement and Declaration Document. This is the responsibility of the keeper, even if your passports are forwarded by the S.A.C. office.

### **Passports and Movements**

- Cattle must be accompanied by the correct passports, all of which should be signed and dated.
- All movements to, and from the market, will be notified electronically to ScotEID by the market. Please do not duplicate the notifications to ScotEID using your own software.

#### Farm Assurance

- Scotch Potential Eligible (SPE) & Scotch Assured (SA) animals offered for sale must have spent the entirety of their lives on QMS Assured holdings in compliance with all QMS Assurance Scheme Standards.
- Farm Assured (FA) animals which may have spent some of their lives on Farm Assured holdings, but don't comply with whole of life assurance.
- Non-Scotch Eligible (NSE) animals that do not meet the standards of any Farm Assurance scheme or have spent their lives on Non-Assured holdings.

#### Vet Attestations

 Holdings who aren't members of the QMS Assurance Scheme but would like to present livestock for sale that is suitable for slaughter, are required to provide proof that the animals have been on holdings that have received at least an annual visit by a vet via a Veterinary Attestation Declaration.

#### **BVD** Declaration

• None of the cattle offered for sale have been moved from a holding which is under BVD movement restriction or, they have been individually tested and have received a negative result.

#### **Compulsory Food Chain Information**

- No cattle or sheep (other than breeding bulls, rams, or young calves) have been moved on to the holding of departure within the past 13 days, and no pigs have been moved on to the holding of departure within the past 20 days.
- The holding is not under movement restrictions for bovine Tuberculosis (T.B.) or any other animal disease or public health reason.
- No illegal substances, or feed, containing ingredients of animal origin have been used in the rearing or finishing of these cattle.
- To the best of my knowledge, none of the animals are showing signs of disease, or condition, that may affect the safety of meat derived from them.
- No analysis of samples, taken from animals, or from the holding, have shown indication that the animals in this consignment have been exposed to any condition that may affect the safety of meat.
- The cattle have not been exposed to any substances likely to result in residues in the meat.
- Withdrawal periods have been observed for all veterinary medicines, and other treatments, administered to the animals while on this, or other holdings.
- The cattle have originated from holdings that have received regular animal health visits from a veterinarian for the purpose of detection and signs of disease.
